

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK BY FR. OWEN KORTE

OUR FIRST HSCP ENGAGED RETREAT: I am so grateful to the Mentor Couples who have put together a great retreat for our parishes' Engaged Couples. Our Marriage Prep Program is second to none. We have each engaged couple choose a young married couple (hopefully with kids) to accompany them in three sessions run by the Mentor Couple (a more experienced couple from the parish who has gone through some training). these couples: Engaged, Accompaniment and Mentor gathered for a day long retreat on April 20. The goal was to form Disciples for Jesus. Thank you for your prayers for all the couples on this retreat this weekend. IT WAS A GREAT EVENT. IN TOTAL WE HAD 80 PEOPLE PRESENT. ABOUT 50 ENGAGED AND 30 HELPERS. PARTICIPANTS GAVE HIGH MARKS TO THE DAY. THANK YOU TO ALL WHO MADE THIS DAY POSSIBLE.

SENIOR MASS: Congratulations to the Seniors from Plainview St. Paul Parish who were honored last Sunday. Thanks to the Ladies for serving a very nice supper to the families afterwards. This week we honor Graduates from Holy Trinity, St. Michael, St. Peter and St. Joseph: from Ponca HS, HNPS, and Cedar. We honor the Osmond Graduates at mass in Osmond this weekend. Randolph will be honoring their graduates at mass on May 5.

CEDAR CATHOLIC NEWS: We are moving towards a change in our administrative leadership. The School Board last year chose to move towards a Lay President model for the School. A representative committee has been meeting to help rework our bylaws to reflect that change. This committee was charged with the goal of better uniting the internal life and the school's relationship with the external support systems. Soon we will bring the bylaws to various parish and school groups for their review and input. There have been many changes in how these kinds of documents are written over the years and the new format follows one that is being used by Pope John XXIII High School which was already approved by our Diocesan Attorneys. We have taken that document and tweaked it to reflect our needs and situation. Cedar Catholic Board has functioned as an advisory board to the priest-president and sometimes like a semi-jurisdictional board. Now the board will be more semi-jurisdictional with reserved powers spelled out as belonging to the Archbishop.

in the Pro-Abortion Ballot Proposal?

THIS CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT...

REMOVES PARENTAL RIGHTS

By using all "persons" instead of "women," any girl under the age of 18 could have an abortion without her parent's consent or knowledge.

LEAVES "HEALTH" UNDEFINED

Court cases define "health" exceptions to include emotional, psychological, and familial well-being.

THREATENS ALL HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS

The amendment risks eliminating 50 years of common-sense protections for women and girls against unsafe abortion practices. After passing a similar constitutional amendment, Michigan quickly repealed informed consent laws, and state licensing and inspection requirements for abortion facilities.

GIVES ABORTIONISTS THE SOLE DISCRETION TO DECIDE VIABILITY

Women seeking an abortion don't see their OBGYN or family doctor. They go to abortion practitioners. This ballot initiative gives power to abortion practitioners, who may not even be licensed doctors, to decide whether a baby is 'viable."

CREATES A RIGHT TO LATE-PREGNANCY ABORTION

Bables born as late as 32-36 weeks need machines to help them breathe. This is an "extraordinary medical measure" necessary for their life outside the womb. Under the ballot proposal language, these bables are not "viable" and may be aborted.

ARTICLE I, SECTION 31

OF THE NEBRASKA STATE CONSTITITION
SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ...

"All persons shall have a fundamental right to abortion

until fetal viability, or when needed to protect the life or

health of the pregnant patient,

without interference from the

state or its political subdivisions.

Fetal viability means the point

in pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the

patient's treating health care

practitioner, there is a

significant likelihood of the

fetus' sustained survival

outside the uterus without the

application of extraordinary

medical measures."

While Saint Joseph's primary feast day is March 19th, in 1955 Pope Pius XII added a second day on May 1st, celebrated as the Memorial of St. Joseph the Worker. Pope Pius Worker XII instituted this memorial at the beginning of
