FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK BY FR. OWEN KORTE

A DEEP PERSONAL ENCOUNTER WITH THE LORD: This is what I want for the youth of our parishes who are preparing for their confirmation. All the research tells us that if the faith is to survive in a person's life it will happen if they have had a deep personal encounter with the Lord Jesus. This is what our camp provides: It is a good camp retreat. It is led by faith filled people and includes witness talks by youth and adults, small group sharing, fun activities to drive home the themes, good food, good prayer time, masses, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, confession, distractions removed, recreation and games that keep their teenage bodies ready to support a spirit that is hungry for the Lord—and so much more. I ask you to trust me on this and give it a chance. It is well worth the sacrifice. It is the way we have found the Holy Spirit wants to work in our kids lives. The team is already meeting to prepare. For 40 years now kids have sacrificed baseball games and out of town tournaments to attend the camp. No one has complained about that compared to the encounter they had with the Lord Jesus at the Camp and the friendships they formed.

CEDAR CATHOLIC NEWS: We are moving towards a change in our administrative leadership. The School Board last year chose to move towards a Lay President model for the School. A representative committee has been meeting to help rework our bylaws to reflect that change. This committee was charged with the goal of better uniting the internal life and the school's relationship with the external support systems. Soon we will bring the bylaws to various parish and school groups for their review and input. There have been many changes in how these kinds of documents are written over the years and the new format follows one that is being used by Pope John XXIII High School which was already approved by our Diocesan Attorneys. We have taken that document and tweaked it to reflect our needs and situation. Cedar Catholic Board has functioned as an advisory board to the priest-president and sometimes like a semi-jurisdictional board. Now the board will be more semi-jurisdictional with reserved powers spelled out as belonging to the Archbishop.

NOTE TO HOLY TRINITY PARISHIONERS: We will be doing a bit of remodel in the church. Our restrooms are certainly not made for people with any mobility issues, especially getting in with a wheel chair. You would call them NON-handicap accessible. I had always dreamed of us having our own hall on the south side of the church, connected to the church via the lobby, with new restrooms. Then a narthex (lobby) could be made larger. Maybe that will happen someday or not. For now we are going to take the men's restroom and the small storage room you walk through to get there and make it into a handicap accessible bathroom for both men and women. Work on this will start after school is out. For weddings and funerals we will use Cedar Catholic for restrooms also. Would you like to help with the costs. We are projecting about \$10,000 to accomplish this. Just write a check and drop it off at the office or via the collection basket. Mark it clearly for this project.

NOTE TO ST PAUL PARISHIONERS: Don't forget to make a good donation to the roof project. Shingles have been ordered and will be arriving shortly. Make checks out to St. Paul Parish Roof Project. Thanks for your help in caring for what our ancestors left us.

OUR HISTORIC CROSS-COUNTRY JOURNEY WITH JESUS BEGINS THIS MONTH.

The routes are set, stops are finalized, and dioceses across the country are eagerly preparing to welcome Jesus as he passes through on his way to the 10th National Eucharistic Congress. 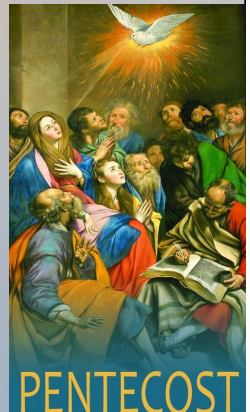

How do we know when we receive the Holy Spirit?:

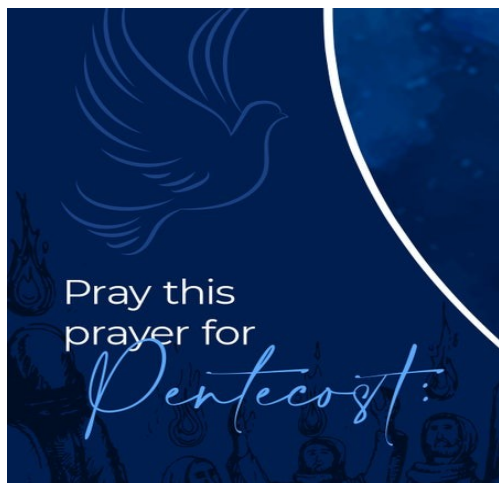
My brothers and I discovered something as we got older. There's a little bit of dad in us. Each time we catch ourselves using one of his gestures, expressions, or comments, we say, "I'm getting more like Dad!" Many laughs and good-natured kidding have come out of it.

When we are confirmed, we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit. There is no radical change in us that makes us seem suddenly different. Over a period of time, we come to see that there is a little bit of the Spirit in us. We catch ourselves using the gifts, and often end up wondering where a bit of wisdom came from, or why we were so patient, or we feel an intensity in our prayer. Perhaps we felt drawn to deepen our spiritual life or found courage in witnessing to our faith. That's when we know we have received the Holy Spirit. We take on his image. Yes, we grow in age, grace and wisdom, but we also grow in our awareness and understanding of the working of God in our life. We start realizing we're getting more and more like God. Our thoughts, words and actions carry that quality and others too, see it in us. You might call it holiness. But be confident! There's a little bit of him in all of us. ©LPI




