## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK BY FR. OWEN KORTE

**CEDAR CATHOLIC NEWS:** We are moving towards a change in our administrative leadership. The School Board last year chose to move towards a Lay President model for the School. A representative committee has been meeting to help rework our bylaws to reflect that change. This committee was charged with the goal of better uniting the internal life and the school's relationship with the external support systems. Soon we will bring the bylaws to various parish and school groups for their review and input. There have been many changes in how these kinds of documents are written over the years and the new format follows one that is being used by Pope John XXIII High School which was already approved by our Diocesan Attorneys. We have taken that document and tweaked it to reflect our needs and situation. Cedar Catholic Board has functioned as an advisory board to the priest-president and sometimes like a semi-jurisdictional board. Now the board will be more semi-jurisdictional with reserved powers spelled out as belonging to the Archbishop.

**NOTE TO HOLY TRINITY PARISHIONERS:** We will be doing a bit of remodel in the church. Our restrooms are certainly not made for people with any mobility issues, especially getting in with a wheel chair. You would call them NON-handicap accessible. I had always dreamed of us having our own hall on the south side of the church, connected to the church via the lobby, with new restrooms. Then a narthex (lobby) could be made larger. Maybe that will happen someday or not. For now, we are going to take the men's restroom and the small storage room you walk through to get there and make it into a handicap accessible bathroom for both men and women. Work on this will start after school is out. For weddings and funerals we will use Cedar Catholic for restrooms also. Would you like to help with the costs. We are projecting about \$10,000 to accomplish this. Just write a check and drop it off at the office or via the collection basket. Mark it clearly for this project.

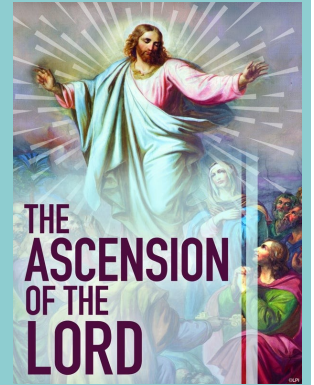

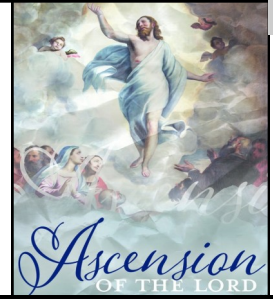

## *A Word from Deacon Filips...*

Greetings prayer warriors!

We are still in Easter season. It lasts 50 days after Easter Sunday until Pentecost. We start preparing for Easter during the 40 days of Lent. By devoting 90 days total,  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the year to the resurrection of Jesus, the church is indicating it is more important than any other day in the year.

If the resurrection is true, then the possibilities for our future are mind boggling. Jesus had to die because He was fully human, and crucifixion is lethal. He resurrected because He was fully God. He became man because our sins are human, and therefore a human had to pay for them. But because sin is so offensive to God, only the death of God can pay that debt, crucifying one of us would not have paid the debt, only the Son of God could do that, so God's solution was to be incarnated as true man and true god, so He could pay the debt of humans with the authority of God.

By His suffering and death, Jesus opened the gates of Heaven for all of us and by His resurrection, He broke the power of death and shows us what we will experience at the resurrection of the dead at the end of time. By taking a human body to heaven, He shows us where we can follow. He left us His church and sacraments to lead and nourish us on the way to where He is. The church is Christ's body, and He is our head, and He is already in heaven waiting for us to join Him there. By joining Christ's body in baptism, we have access to the trinity. We get to enter the Holy Trinity with Christ as our head and us as part of His body! All we must do is stay in relationship with Jesus and stay as pure as we can so we can go there quickly after we die.

### **Liturgy of the Word:**

On Sundays and Holy Days, there are three Scripture readings, the first is from the Old Testament or Acts of the Apostles.

A selection of Psalms either sung or recited.

A New Testament reading, usually one of Paul's letters.

Then the Deacon or Priest proclaims the Gospel acclamation followed by a reading from one of the Gospels as we stand.

The Priest or Deacon gives a homily, relating the readings to the lives of the people.

The Nicene Creed, summarizing what we believe as Christians is recited on Sundays and solemnities.

Prayers of the Faithful, in which we bring our concerns to God.

**Pope's Intention:** *For the formation of religious and seminarians. We pray that religious women and men, and seminarians, grow in their own vocations through their human, pastoral, spiritual and community formation, leading them to be credible witnesses to the Gospel.*

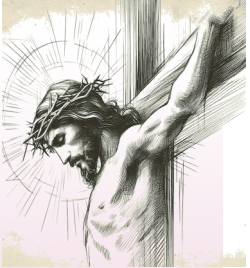

Once a man came to the Vatican and asked to see Pope John Paul II, claiming that they had been friends in Poland. When told of the man, the Pope said, "He is mistaken about our friendship. I don't recall ever having suffered with him." As it turned out, the man had never known the Pope. Now, I'm not sure if the story is totally factual. But doesn't the juxtaposition of suffering with friendship sound exactly like JPII? He understood that the deepest and most lasting friendships are forged in the fires of shared suffering. No suffering, no friendship. Amazing.

This week we hear Jesus say to the apostles and to us, "You are my friends if you do what I command you" (John 15:14). In Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, God entered the world of human suffering and transformed it into an avenue of friendship with Himself. Following His command — to love, to lay down our lives for others — will always entail suffering. But this suffering only deepens our friendship with Him. His suffering is ours; ours is His. We have become friends of God.

This week, how might you share your suffering with the Risen Jesus? How might he be sharing his suffering with you, in the lives of those around you? Be attentive to that, and you'll find that you are indeed a friend of God, because you've suffered together a great deal. — Father John Muir ©LPi


